Welcome First Timers!

First Time Participants are encouraged to complete a pink Newcomer Information Form. This will assist the Ministry to find out what you are looking for. In addition, it will enter you in our data base which will put you on the mailing list.

Church Street Singles encourages participants to fellowship and greet/meet fellow singles.

To assist in this we ask that all participants wear a name badge at all functions. And there are two types, **RED** and **BLACK**.

- o The **RED** badges are for first time participants.
- o The **BLACK** badges are for “veterans.”

What is an Open Forum?

Open Forum is a group directed discussion. The group will be given five questions for round table discussion on a specific topic. Participants may speak freely on each of the five statements.

What is Fish Bowl ?

Fish Bowl is an opportunity for individuals to ask members of the opposite gender questions they have always wanted to ask. For example,

“Why is it that women always.....?”

Or, “Why do all men.....?”

Everyone is given a 3x5 card (**ladies pink** and **gentlemen blue**). On the card each individual writes their question. The cards then are placed in a giant Fish Bowl. The facilitator draws cards and asks the questions. Members of the targeted gender group then may respond to the question.

First Thursday Feast and Flick Social Port-of-Entry

First Thursday of the month Church Street Singles gather for dinner and a movie. After the Feast it's off to the Singleplex (across Parish Hall) where the gathered group will vote to see one of the eight movie options “now playing” at the Singleplex.

Second Thursday
